What Is Barbershop Harmony?

- 4-part harmony with singing parts for tenor, lead, baritone, and bass
- Unique to barbershop, the melody part is the lead, the second highest pitched voice part. The tenor, baritone, and bass parts create the characteristic **barbershop chords** that include lots of "**7th chords**"... whatever they are. (Ask our director.)
- When all parts sing **vowels** in the **same way** and precisely **on pitch**, then higher **harmonic sounds** are created that seem to soar and **ring** through the roof.
- "**Ringing**" chords tend to send chills down your spine and make your neck hairs stand up.

Audition Requirement

You must audition to join the chorus. First your best voice range and singing part will be determined. Then grab some music and join us on the risers. Our chorus members will sing with you and help all along the way so you can audition when you feel prepared and ready.

The director will evaluate your ability to sing your voice part accurately while the other three parts are being sung along with you. Informal coaching and support is available at every rehearsal session.
